All exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that all relevant legislative obligations are met with regard to safety, Workers Compensation and food safety. In addition, all leads and equipment used on the showground must be tagged and tested.

Exhibitors will be granted access from 12 noon Thursday 10th September.
